Useful Pieces of Information for Conference Guests in Jena

1 How to get to the Rosensäle

The Rosensäle are located at **Fürstengraben 27**, right next to the Pulverturm.

Look for a historic sandstone building opposite the Botanical Garden – the entrance is clearly marked.





2 How to get to Accouchierhaus

From the Rosensäle, walk a short distance east along Fürstengraben and turn right. The Accouchierhaus (**Jenergasse 8**) is just under a minute's stroll, even faster than what is suggested on Google Maps.

3 How to get to Papiermühle

From Fürstengraben 27 (Rosensäle), head west along Fürstengraben/B7 and continue straight for about 2.1 km/1.3 miles.

The Papiermühle is on the right at **Erfurter Straße 102**, just past the edge of the city center.



4 Taking the Bus to Papiermühle

From **Johannisplatz**, take Bus 16 toward Mühlthal—it runs approximately every 15 minutes on weekdays—and get off at Jena/**Mühlthal**, just in front of the brewpub, after a ride of about 10 minutes.

5 Buying Bus Tickets

You can buy tickets on the bus (cash/card/Visa), via the FAIRTIQ app (swipe “Start” before boarding, “Stop” after exit; card/PayPal), or in the DB app (card/PayPal), e.g. for a trip from Johannisplatz to Mühlthal. A single ride (Einzelfahrt) within Jena costs 2,70 €.

6 Where to eat nearby

Just a short walk away, the city center offers plenty of dining options. For a great meal, head to Wagnergasse, a street famous with locals for its cozy cafés and diverse restaurants. For a cheap lunch try the famous fries from Fritz Mitte.
